Dear Huntington Parents and Students,

As you may have noticed, our building is now under construction with the renovation well underway. Due to the delay in getting started, the original plans have been revised, but the priority is to get the front bus loop completed as soon as possible. It is expected that by the end of October or mid November, school busses will drop off and pick up students in the front of the building, and the traffic circle on the east (pool) side of the building will also be complete. In addition, the pool will be under construction until December, but after that will be ready for use with many new updates. Work will also begin on many other renovations and updates inside the building, including new windows and flooring in classrooms, a new elevator, new student bathrooms, a new front entrance and main office, and other updates.

Until then however, both parking lots will be closed and parents (except PreK parents) and staff vehicles will not have access to the building beyond Sunnycrest Road. We are working with the District and the City to find solutions to this however. As we prepare for the opening of school on September 6th, we will have plans in place to ensure the safety of our walkers, drop-off's, and bussers, and will communicate those arrival and dismissal plans via written notices, ROBO calls, and social media.

We are excited about the progress being made and are looking forward to the completed project. When complete, Huntington PK8 School will once again reflect the beauty and pride of the Eastwood community.
