

PARENT SURVEY QUESTIONS

- 1) *Do you know what the vision of this school is? What do you think the school's goals are?*

 - 2) *As you know, every child is unique. In your view, do teachers and other school personnel make every effort to gain accurate knowledge about your child and use this knowledge to meet his/her needs and help them achieve their goals? During your time at the school, have you observed teachers and other school personnel making special efforts to treat everyone respectfully and fairly?*

 - 3) *If your child is receiving these services, are school personnel involved? How did you learn about these services? Who made you aware of these services? Are you actively involved in these services, or are they exclusively focused on your child? Do you communicate with the principal, teachers, and other school personnel about your child's progress and needs? Explain.*

 - 4) *Are you aware of community agencies that are involved with the school to support and address student support and growth?*

 - 5) *Have you faced any challenges regarding your child's social or emotional health or academic needs while at this school? Could you provide any examples of times when your child has broken a school or classroom rule? How was this communicated to you?*

 - 6) *A school's climate can be described as the quality of a school's life and character. Thinking about this school's climate, how would you describe it from your point of view? Please tell me how you have felt when you have been in this building? How does your child talk about this school's climate? Do you feel your child is safe here?*
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7) Do you interact regularly with school personnel (e.g., principal, teachers, and other employees)? If so, describe your interactions.

8) Have teachers and other school personnel asked you to work closely with them to improve your child's academic learning and achievement?

9) In what ways do your child's teachers inform you about their academic achievement?

How do they communicate with you? Please describe it. Is the information they give you clear and understandable? Is the information complete? Do you wish they would tell you things in different ways? (More often? In other languages?) Is the information right? Who do you contact if you think something is wrong with the information you received? Is there a better way for them to communicate with you or other families?

10) In what ways, if any, have you been involved in volunteer activities in the school? *Could you describe those experiences? How did you become involved in the volunteer activity?*

11) Have school personnel reached out to you to ask how they might help you and/or offer social support your family? If so, who contacted you? How did it go?
